

Orchard Place access on Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 August

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

We're writing to let you know about vehicle access to and from East India Dock Road and Orchard Place, and the surrounding areas, during the London T100 Triathlon on Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 August.

Lower Lea Crossing will be closed to traffic on both days, from 07:00 to 18:30 on the Saturday and from 04:30 to 16:30 on the Sunday. Access plans are in place to help residents and businesses make essential journeys. The arrangements are different on both days, so please see the details below and the map over the page.

Access on Saturday 9 August

Lower Lea Crossing will be closed from 07:00 to 18:30 on Saturday 9 August. During this time, event stewards will facilitate local access to and from East India Dock Road and Orchard Place via Leamouth Road and Lower Lea Crossing.

Access on Sunday 10 August

On Sunday 10 August, Leamouth Roundabout will be closed from 04:30 to 14:00, and Lower Lea Crossing will be closed from 04:30 to 16:30.

During this time, stewards will facilitate local access to and from East India Dock Road and Orchard Place via Cotton Street, Preston's Road, Baffin Way, Blackwall Way, and Lower Lea Crossing.

Signs and stewards

Diversion signs will be in place and stewards will be present. Please follow the instructions of stewards at all times.

Important information for Wapping – road closures on Sunday 10 August

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Road closures are required in Wapping on Sunday 10 August as part of the London T100 Triathlon. Please see the road closure timetable and map over the page.

As in previous years, the event will start and finish at ExCeL London and feature a variety of triathlon distances. The event routes are shown over the page and are also available online at **t100triathlon.com**

Road closures

It will be necessary to close several roads along the route for the event to take place. East Smithfield and The Highway, near Wapping, will be closed from 04:30 until 14:00 on Sunday 10 August.

Vehicle access routes for Wapping residents will be available during the event period. Please see below and over the page for more details.

Vehicle access for Wapping

On Sunday 10 August, there will be managed vehicle access to and from the area south of The Highway.

Event stewards will facilitate alternate single-file access in both directions to and from Thomas More Street, along East Smithfield, and Tower Bridge from 04:30 until 14:00. Tower Bridge will be open for local access to and from Wapping only during this time. See the pink access route on the map over the page.

Two vehicle crossing points across The Highway will also be in operation. Stewards will facilitate northbound and southbound access at Dock Street/Vaughan Way (yellow route on the map over the page) and at Glamis Road until approximately 06:30 and after 12:00 only.

If you need to make a journey during the time the vehicle crossing points are closed (between 06:30 and 12:00), you may wish to consider parking north of The Highway on Saturday 9 August.


